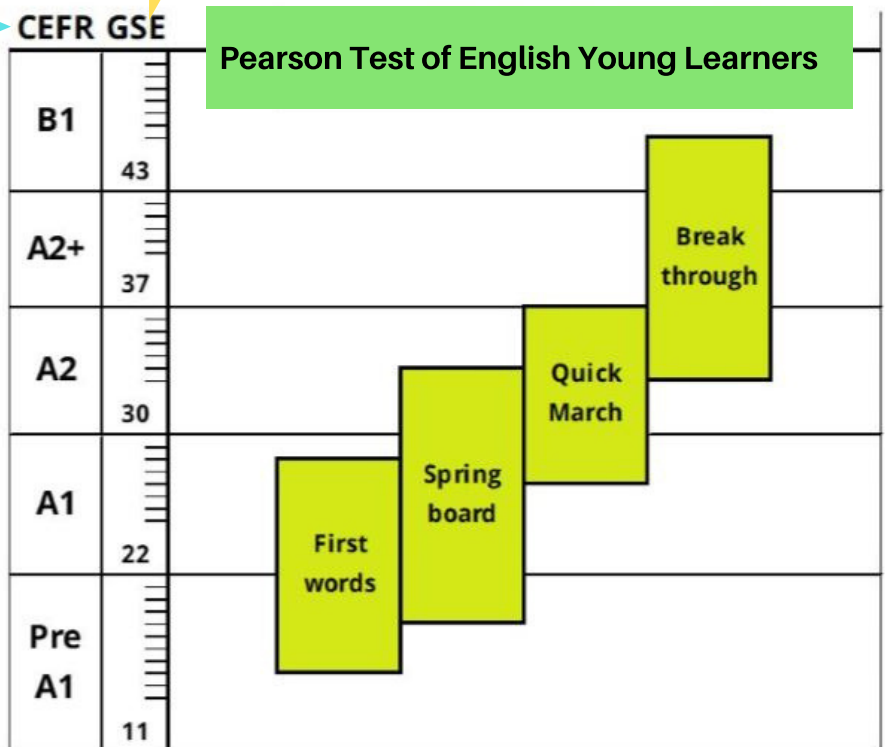


The Global Scale of English (GSE)

Global Scale of English (GSE)

is a standardised, granular scale which measures English language proficiency. Unlike some other frameworks which describe attainment in broad bands, the GSE identifies what a learner can do at each point on the scale across speaking, listening, reading and writing skills. The scale is from 10 to 90.

The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) uses a six-level classification of learner proficiency from A1 (low basic) to C2 (fully proficient)
